**Eligibility Criteria for Admission under ME-ME (Multiple Entry – Multiple Exit)
Framework of NEP 2020**

1. The candidate must have successfully completed the First Year/Second Year of the relevant undergraduate programme from a recognized Higher Education Institution/HAEI/University implementing NEP 2020 and must possess the corresponding UG Certificate/UG Diploma, as applicable.
2. The parent institution must be registered under the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), and all credits earned by the candidate must have been duly deposited and verified in the candidate's ABC account.
3. The candidate must have completed the preceding year(s) in the same or an equivalent discipline/programme in which admission to the Second/Third Year is sought. The prescribed 10 weeks internship mandated under the applicable programme, must have been completed.
4. The candidate must have secured a minimum CGPA of 6.00 on a 10-point scale or equivalent and fulfilled all academic requirements for the relevant stage of the programme.
5. Admission shall be subject to verification and mapping of credits.
6. All eligible candidates shall be required to appear in an online/offline written screening test to assess subject knowledge, academic preparedness and aptitude. Admission shall be subject to merit, credit equivalence, availability of seats and applicable regulatory rules.
